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1. “Nature of the Indian Constitution is reflective of the context in which it was drafted and also the future demands of the society”. Elaborate upon the above statement.
 2. A special court was constituted to try the offences committed by MLAs and MPs. The law creating such Court provided for speedier trial of such cases. X challenges the law on the basis of it being violative of Article 14 of the Constitution. Advice X.
 3. The Government of India came up with a notification under which licenses to run provision shops can be cancelled without any hearing in cases of complaints of denial of ration to the ration card holders. Decide in light of case laws and relevant provisions.
 4. The recommendation of the collegium with respect to the appointment of a Supreme Court Judge was referred back by the Government to the collegium for reconsideration. The collegium reiterated the recommendation. What are the options available with the Government now? Explain by enunciating process of appointment of a Supreme Court Judge in the light of ‘Judges cases’.
 5. An amendment to the Constitution takes away the power of the Judicial review of the High Courts. Critically examine the above amendment in the light of decided cases.
 6. Write short notes on the following-
 - a) Doctrine of Harmonious Construction.
 - b) Ordinance making power of the executive.
