- Q1. Identify the four components of the IRAC method in the case given to you (IRAC – Identify I in one sentence, R in two sentences, Explain A in 100 words, C in one sentence) **(Marks – 2+4+6+2 =14)**
- Q2. Briefly identify the contentions of the parties before the Supreme Court. Also clearly identify the sources of law they relied on? **(100+100=200 words, 5+5= 10 marks)**
- Q3. Briefly state the *ratio decidendi* of the case **(20 words – 5 marks)**
- Q4. Identify:
- i. Various fora through which the case passed before reaching the Supreme Court **(10 words, 3 marks)**
 - ii. Identify the kind of proceedings initiated in the High Court and the Supreme Court **(10 words, 4 marks)**
 - iii. Identify the position taken (i.e. claim of which party was upheld) by each of the fora right upto the Supreme Court **(20 words, 3 marks)**

- i. Classify the approach of the court towards law as reflected in para 9 and para 10 **(100+100=200 words, 4+4=8 marks)**
 - ii. What do they tell us about the nature of law and adjudication? **(500 words, 10 marks)**
- Q6. Write a short note on the following:
- i. Rules of interpretation with corresponding usage **(300 words, 6 marks)**
 - ii. Common law legal culture **(200 words, 3 marks)**
 - iii. Compare adversarial and inquisitorial procedures **(250 words, 4 marks)**
