- Q.1. Is Human Rights purely a western concept? Discuss the contribution of religious theologies in evolution and development of the jurisprudence of international human rights law. (10 Marks)

- Q.3. Discuss the relationship between state and human rights; and how the principles of *sovereignty of state* and *domestic jurisdiction* are still decisive in terms of enforcement of the international human rights. (10 Marks)

(b)Discuss if the idea of *cultural relativism* can be a valid defence against the enforcement of international human rights law in India context. (5 Marks)

Q.5. Discuss the relationship between Caste and human rights; and if the existing international human rights framework is capable of responding to the problem of Caste.
